#### **SAVE WITH SURPLUS!**

The Rose Hill Community Larder, based at Rose Hill Community centre, runs in partnership with SOFEA (South Oxfordshire Food and Education Alliance).

Users sign up to pay £14 per month and each week can take 10 grocery items plus fruit and vegetables.

Typical groceries include porridge, pasta, rice, tinned goods, vegetable oil and cereal, as well as chocolate and snacks such as crisps and cake. Fruit and vegetables are plentiful; anything from mangoes to mushrooms!

Sometimes there are extras to take away too, such as household cleaning items, toothpaste and shampoo, nappies or pet food.

Mandy, a member of the larder said:

"I've made some great family suppers, saved money and met some lovely people. Thank you all and see you next week!"
